VluchtelingenWerk is an independent human rights organization that defends the interests of asylum seekers and refugees in the Netherlands. The FNV is the largest Dutch trade union, representing the interests of employees in the Netherlands.

### **What is the information session about?**

During the information session, the FNV explains topics such as labor law, contracts, collective bargaining agreement, working hours, minimum salary and holidays. There is also an opportunity to ask questions. The information will be given in Dutch with a Ukrainian interpreter for translation.

### **When and where does the information session take place?**

Two information sessions will take place:

- One in Amsterdam on Thursday the 19th of January from 6 pm to 7.30 pm.
- One in Heerhugowaard on Wednesday the 25th of January from 5 pm to 6.30 pm.
